

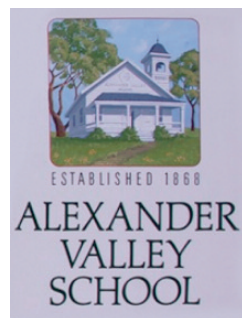

Dear Community Member,

The Alexander Valley Union School District has been providing dedicated and excellent educational services to local students since the formation of the District. Currently, the District educates about 120 students at Alexander Valley Elementary School.

Alexander Valley Elementary School does not have a multi-purpose room. This has been in the plans for nearly 40 years. There is nowhere to hold student assemblies and when it rains, there is no place for children to exercise or eat lunch together. In addition, our kindergarten building is a portable which was installed in 1970. It is in severe need of replacement. Faced with outdated classrooms and the need to bring school facilities up to current standards, the District and Board of Trustees decided to place Measure B, a school improvement general obligation (G.O.) bond measure, on the June 5, 2018 ballot to modernize and renovate our aging school.

If approved, Measure B will allow the District to improve the quality educational environment provided to local children, allowing our school to meet today's safety, technological, and educational standards.
