Through docent led activities, students will take in tide pool discoveries and learn more about the Sonoma County Coastline's natural habitat. 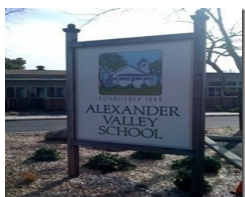
