Dear AVS Parents,

At our last Board Meeting, our Board of Trustees were presented with an informational slidedeck on the variables of the county moving out of the Purple Tier and into the less restrictive Red Tier. This transition allows for an eventual return to a safe and sustainable model of in-person learning at AVS. The slidedeck provides information on the following:

1. Current Covid-19 Tier Placement Metrics including *new* Healthy Quartile Index metric
2. Two tracks for Sonoma County to get from Purple to Red
3. What is the Healthy Equity Index Quartile and Healthy Places Index?
4. Most Recent Trends of Covid-19 Transmission
5. County of Public Health Strategies and resources to reduce Covid-19
6. Top Ten Zip Codes of highest positive Covid-19 case rates in county
7. 7 Steps to the Transitional Reopening of AVS and back to In-Person Learning
8. November and December Mock/Scenario based Calendars pending Tier movement

Towards the end of the slidedeck you will find the Mock/Scenario November/December calendars which detail the 4-week process of advancing through the tier structures given the current state requirements. Each Wednesday, Public Health announces the upcoming week tier placement pending the previous weeks Covid-19 data. Based upon the current data and 4-week structure of maintaining reduced Covid-19 cases and positivity rates, AVS will remain

in our Distance Learning model through December. Every week we remain in the Purple Tier, the return to in-person learning date gets pushed out a week further. We will continue to closely monitor the data trends weekly and provide tier pending/placement updates as we move into December. Once the data trends start to move us towards the Red Tier, we will be issuing a parent survey which will gather your interests around how you are feeling about your child safely returning to in-person learning at AVS. We will not issue this survey until we know there is a possibility of our county advancing through to the Red Tier. Slidedeck Link:
